When choosing your mitigator please Note the following:

1. Make sure that the mitigator does not offer to give out test kits for post-mitigation tests. That is a worthless enticement for real estate transactions and can leave you stranded at closing.
2. You may call us for the post-mitigation test, or the company that did the original test. It's up to you. We do offer discounts on houses we have done before.
3. Ask to verify that if the system fails the post-test within 30 days of the mitigation, then the mitigator will not charge you, the homeowner, for a subsequent test.
4. Ask to verify that the mitigator will not up charge you for additional work if the system fails the post-test.
5. Mitigators are forbidden to sell, for any purpose, electronic radon monitors such as the "Safety Siren"

***After a radon reduction system
is installed schedule your Post-Test!***
